Official Opening 2.00pm Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2008. Prize winning entries will be announced during the Official Opening. An invitation is extended to exhibitors and their guests to attend. Cost is \$5.00 which includes afternoon tea.

## Conditions of Entry

1. Paintings must be original **and** recent works of persons living within 100km of Bellingen and not have been displayed at a previous Bellingen Show.
2. Only two paintings by any one artist may be entered in any one class, with an overall total of six entries.
3. All entries are accepted and displayed at the owner's risk. The Committee accepts no liability for loss, damage or theft. Any freight insurance must be pre-paid by the artist.
4. All entries **MUST** be suitably framed **AND READY FOR HANGING** and clearly marked on the back with name, address, title of work, class and price.
5. All works will be displayed if possible, but the committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
6. The signed entry form is binding; no alteration to price, title or section will be accepted.
7. The Committee shall deduct 25% commission from the catalogue price of Artwork.
8. An acquisitive prize will constitute the full purchase price of the winning entry regardless of any value set by the exhibitor, which then becomes the property of the Bellingen Shire Council.
9. The competitor is responsible for selecting the relevant section for their entries. Works must be entered into the relevant section.
10. The Committee reserves the right to withhold a prize in any section if it is deemed by the judge that the entries are of insufficient standard
11. No paintings may be entered in more than one section.
12. All works to be held for the duration of the exhibition,
13. The Committee reserves the right to have any entry reproduced in the press, television or on the Internet for the purposes of publicity.
14. The decision of the Judge shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down. The Committee's decision will be final.
16. All works not personally collected shall be returned as per instructions. Those that are to be freighted must have prepaid return freight.
17. The artist is deemed to have accepted sole responsibility for ensuring that the works submitted by the artist do not infringe copyright laws.
18. Unsold artworks may be collected from Pavilion Gallery. Bellingen Showground, Black Street, Bellingen from 4:30pm to 5:30pm on Sunday 4 May 2008.
